Frank Monford Graham, was born March 1, 1859 in Birmingham, Illinois; he died August 25, 1931 in Greensboro, Georgia and is buried in Wesley Chapel Cemetery in Greensboro. Georgia. Graham, who wrote this hymn, was also an ordained minister in the Wesleyan (Methodist) Church and served as District Superintendent in northern Georgia from around 1895 to about 1915. He was one of the founders of what is now Southern Wesleyan University at Central, South Carolina.
