A Meditation for You from Our Pastor

BLESSED ARE THE PEACEMAKERS

“Blessed are the peacemakers, For they shall be called sons of God”. Matthew 5:9 (NKJV)

Jesus says in Matthew 5:9 that people who have become sons of God have the character of their Heavenly Father. We know from Scripture that the heavenly Father is a “God of peace” (Romans 16:20; 1 Thessalonians 5:23; Hebrews 13:20), that heaven is a world of peace (Luke 19:38), and most important of all, that God is a peacemaker (2 Corinthians 5:19; Colossians 1:20).

“God was in Christ reconciling the world to himself, not counting their trespasses against them” (2 Corinthians 5:19). “He made peace by the blood of the cross” (Colossians 1:20). Even though by nature we are rebels against God, have committed high treason against him, and are worthy to be eternally court-marshaled and hung by the neck until dead, nevertheless, God has sacrificed his own Son and now declares amnesty free and clear to any who will lay down their arms of independence and come home to faith.

God is a peace-loving God, and a peace-making God. The whole history of redemption, climaxing in the death and resurrection of Jesus, is God’s strategy to bring about a just and lasting peace between rebel man and himself, and then between man and his fellow man. God’s children have the character of their Father. What he loves, they love. What he pursues, they pursue. **You can know his children by whether they are willing to make sacrifices for peace the way God did.**

By the sovereign work of God’s grace, rebel human beings are born again, and brought from rebellion to faith, and made into children of God. We were given a new nature, after the image of our heavenly Father (1 John 3:9). **If He is a peacemaker, then His children, who have His nature, will be peacemakers too.** In Jesus Name Amen.

THE UNION FOUNDATION IS BLESSED TO MAKE THE FOLLOWING ANNOUNCEMENT: Union Baptist Cemetery, the oldest Black-owned Cemetery in Ohio, is the recipient of a \$400,000.00 grant that is funded through the African American Civil Rights of the 20th Century Grant Program and the Historic Preservation Fund. The grant will be administered by the National Park Service, Department of the Interior.

The awarded grant is for preservation and stabilization planning services for structures and objects within the cemetery. It will be used specifically for the restoration of the exterior of the almost 70-year old cemetery building, repair of monuments and headstones, and restoration of fencing.

The History of Family Communion at Union Baptist Church

The Family Communion was instituted with the worship celebration service of Union by the sixteenth Pastor, the Reverend Wilber A. Page. The first celebration was observed on the first Sunday evening, December 4, 1932 at 7:30 p.m.

The purpose for instituting Family Communion was to have each family together on the last Lord's Supper Observance of the year. The Union Baptist Church Membership was not concerned as to whether all the families were members of this church. Their mission was to invite members of their families from other surrounding churches to partake in the Lord's Supper together.

The Union Baptist Church family recognized that the Lord's Supper was not instituted by any one denomination, but that it was to be observed by all Christians.

All Believers in Christ, members of the visible church are obligated to partake of it. It represents His body broken for many; His blood shed for many. He commanded Christians to "Do this in remembrance of me." (*I Corinthians 11:17-34*).

This Observance of the Lord's Supper (Holy Communion) has always represented Christian unity in the body of Christ. These Eighty-eight years have brought to us a blessed and lasting fellowship.

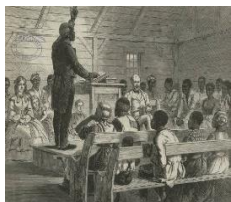

The first Watch Night service was on December 31, 1862. On that night, also known as "Freedom's Eve", Black slaves and free blacks came together in churches and private homes all across the nation awaiting news that the Emancipation Proclamation actually had become law. Lincoln had used the occasion of the Union victory at Antietam to issue a preliminary proclamation, which freed all slaves in the rebellious states after January 1, 1863. *The African American Desk Reference*
