A Meditation for You from Our Pastor

Mighty Warrior

One day the angel of God came and sat down under the oak in Ophrah that belonged to Joash the Abiezrite, whose son Gideon was threshing wheat in the winepress... The angel of God appeared to him and said, "God is with you, O mighty warrior!" - Judges 6:11-12 MSG

Do you know that you are a Mighty Warrior, a soldier in the Army of the Lord? He has equipped you to do great things. Be inspired by the following message:

Dear Children:

I see things in you that you have no idea you possess. I see you as brave, determined, loving, kind, gentle and simply amazing. You see, I know what you are equipped for. Every moment, hour, day, month, year, you are becoming more of what I created you to be. You may be saying to yourself, "Why, I'm no one special. I'm just an ordinary worker, parent, spouse, daughter, son, sister, brother, friend, artist, believer." But dear friend, you are so much more. You are mighty in courage and love. <u>UNITED COLORED AMERICAN CEMETERY AWARDED OHIO HISTORY MARKER:</u> The United Colored American Cemetery located on Duck Creek Road in Madisonville has been accepted into the Ohio Historical Markers program. Of the fifty-three applications submitted in April, 2023 to the remarkable Ohio program in response to their call for topics and locations focusing on under-represented populations, the United Colored American Cemetery is one of only twenty-two awarded this year. The United Colored American Cemetery, dedicated in May, 1883, is the resting place of Underground Railroad leaders as well as writers, politicians, neighborhood activists, businesspeople, artists, Civil Rights leaders, and many military veterans including at least 55 African American Cemetery is owned and operated by Union Baptist Church.

The William G. Pomeroy Foundation has also awarded a grant towards the full cost of the marker. A dedication ceremony for the marker will be held in 2024, with a specific date to be announced once the marker has been created. He is the Professor of Urban Ministry and chair of the Metro-Urban Institute Council at Pittsburgh Theological Seminary and co-convener of the Transatlantic Roundtable on Religion and Race.

The forum will continue on Tuesday and Wednesday September 12 and September 13, 2023 from 7:00 p.m. to 8:30 pm with **Mr. Frederick E. O'Neal**, the presenter. He will focus on the following theme on both nights: "**The Intergenerational Witness: Perspectives on Today's Black Church"**.

Mr. O'Neal is a businessman, church leader, and community volunteer in the Carroll County, West Georgia area. Mr. O'Neal is currently pursuing a Doctorate of Ministry Degree at Pittsburgh Theological Seminary with a **focused specialization in Intergenerational Black Church**.
