A Meditation for You from Our Pastor

Put Spring in Your Spirit

Ask Jesus to plant fresh seeds of joy in your heart.

"Sing to God a brand-new song, sing his praises all over the world! Let the sea and its fish give a round of applause, with all the far-flung islands joining in. Let the desert and its camps raise a tune, calling the Kedar nomads to join in. Let the villagers in Sela round up a choir and perform from the tops of the mountains. Make God's glory resound; echo his praises from coast to coast." Isaiah 42:10 (MSG)

I love the freshness of spring each year. I walk with more pep in my step and more vitality. I enjoy more color in my face and a boost in my spirit. Everything about spring breathes of life and newness. I love seeing green fields, and trees and flowers begin budding. I can't help but lift my face to thank Jesus for the smile He gave me through His wonderful creation of springtime.

I guess that's why I love **Isaiah 42:10**, which draws a picture of a world reveling in the joy of praising God. I can almost hear it. It's amazing how God—the Ancient of Days, the Omega, the One Who Was and Is and Is to Come—is Lord not only of our past, but also of our future. He is Lord of all that will be new as he makes it beautiful in his time. (**Ecclesiastes 3:11**.)

Imagine the newness experienced by people whose lives spanned the time before Jesus' birth until after His death. The handful of people who believed in Him back then felt not only the longing for the Messiah but also the joy that He paid the penalty for our sins and is alive forevermore!

If springlike praise has faded in your heart, ask Jesus to plant in you fresh seeds of joy. If we desire clean hearts, we must start by asking for them. "Create in me a pure heart, O God, and renew a steadfast spirit within me." (Psalm 51:10). After we've prayed for guidance, we need to wade into the clutter and grime of our hearts—and let the cleaning begin!

Consider these suggestions:

1. Scan for big problems you might have overlooked.

Take some time to think through the Ten Commandments (**Exodus 20:2–17**) in the Bible. Are there any you're not living out fully? If you find you're tripping over God's Word, confess it—and ask God to sweep, or spiritually spring clean, your sin away.

2. Dust off your irritations.

Think of the things (or people) that annoy you regularly and ask yourself if anything is going on in your own heart that contributes to the problem. To do your spiritual spring cleaning, let go of the negative things in your life and invite the positive ones in—like peace, hope, and love. And remember, "[love] is not rude, it is not self-seeking, it is not easily angered, it keeps no record of wrongs" (1 Corinthians 13:5). (continued)

3. Consider the clutter of your days.

What could you fling from your life that's cluttering your relationship with God? One TV show a day? A tidbit of gossip when you get together with friends? An indulgence that might be cultivating a spirit of selfishness? Look at the small things. The Bible warns us that it's "the little foxes that ruin the vineyards" (Song of Solomon 2:15).

4. Contemplate what's lacking.

What we fail to do often depletes our spiritual health as much as what we do wrong. We want to be among those to whom Christ says, "For I was hungry and you gave me something to eat, I was thirsty and you gave me something to drink, I was a stranger and you invited me in, I needed clothes and you clothed me, I was sick and you looked after me, I was in prison and you came to visit me" (Matthew 25:35-36). As you do your spiritual spring cleaning, think of what more you can do in your life to help others and live with spiritual wellbeing.

God longs to purify you from your sins, to wash you and make your heart "whiter than snow" (Psalm 51:7) ...every season of the year. Take the steps to undergo a spiritual spring cleaning and with the Lord help and guidance of the Holy Spirit it will benefit your life through the spring season and beyond. Amen.
