A Meditation for You from Our Pastor

New Beginnings

It is of the Lord's mercies that we are not consumed, because his compassions fail not.

They are new every morning: great is thy faithfulness. (Lamentations 3:22-23 KJV)

Greetings Union:

Spring is approaching. Praise the Lord! We have so many reasons to celebrate the newness that it brings, including the following:

1. New Life and Resurrection:

Spring is a season of renewal and new beginnings. Just as nature awakens from its winter slumber, Christians associate spring with the **resurrection** of Jesus Christ.

Easter, the central event of our faith, occurs during spring. It commemorates Jesus' victory over death and His rising from the grave.

2. God's Creative Nature

Spring showcases God's **creativity**. Take a closer look at the delicate petals of a daffodil, the beautiful budding of the hostages and begonias, or the vibrant flight of a bluebird or cardinal.

God's creativity extends beyond nature; it's evident in your unique life story. Your testimony is unlike anyone else's, and through Jesus' sacrificial death, new life blooms.

3. Joy and Transformation:

After a long, cold winter, the arrival of spring brings joy. Green leaves appear, flowers bloom, and smiles abound.

Similarly, when a person turns to Jesus, joy floods their soul. The gospel transforms hearts, replacing spiritual dreariness with abundant life.

4. God's Faithfulness:

Just as we trust that spring will arrive each year, we can rely on God's **faithfulness**. He forgives our sins and offers new beginnings.

Like leaves falling to the ground, we must die to ourselves to allow new growth. God's faithfulness ensures that life follows death, both in nature and in our spiritual journey.

The season of Lent is now, and it invites each of us to examine our brokenness and spiritual hunger. It prepares us for the Resurrection Celebration or Easter by reminding us that we need the Savior, that we are lost without God's grace. We can't save ourselves or fix all our problems. We are dust and ashes, lost and blind without God's mercy. Let us repent of any prideful attitudes that we may have. Trust God and allow Him to direct our paths and lean not unto our own understanding and He will direct our paths. (Proverbs 3:5-6)

Hope and healing are on the way, so let us rejoice as God works His perfect plans out through each of us. Our hearts should be filled with praise for all that God has done and will do for us. He has changed the focus and purpose of our lives because He sent His Son Jesus to pay penalty for our sin debt. If you have not done so, accept the Lord Jesus by faith as your Lord and Savior today and receive the gift of eternal life. Just as Lent's call to humility is good for our hearts, clinging to the hope of better days can bring us healing. We can let go of our fears and worries. We can look ahead with joyful anticipation. That's the promise of Spring, and even more, the promise of resurrection. God has good things in store that will renew our rejoicing.

As we kindle this hope, we also remember that life in this world will have troubles and sorrows. There will be other global crises and personal tragedies. On this side of heaven, we will walk through more dark valleys, but God will walk with us in those tough times just as He has walked with us through the years of the pandemic. His promises don't change with the seasons. His love lasts through the dark nights. Rejoicing will come again in the morning. When we consider the greatness of God's love, His grace in sending Jesus Christ to die for us and rise again, and what He has delivered us from, we cannot keep from praising Him and proclaiming to others how He changed our lives!
