<u>A Meditation for You from Our Pastor</u>

MAKE YOUR SUMMER SEASON ABOUT GOD

Make your ear attentive to wisdom and [incline] your heart to understanding; yes, if you call out for insight and raise your voice for understanding, if you seek it like silver and search for it as for hidden treasures, then you will understand the fear of the Lord and find the knowledge of God. **Proverbs 2:2-5 ESV**

No one should ever take a break from God, his glory, and the mission he gives each of us. When we break for the summer from some of our regular activities, God still calls us to seek Him with all our heart, soul, mind, and strength. The Bible constantly calls believers to an all-out, fullabandoned pursuit of wisdom as **Proverbs 2:2-5** declares.

This summer season does not give us permission to pull up a lawn chair and watch the race instead of running the race. When we think of summer activities, and vacations, make sure we don't disengage from seeking God. We should never neglect meeting together and praising Him more, loving Him better, and having more fuel to live for His glory. Don't waste your summer by ceasing to pursue God in all that you do.

Jesus Christ is the refreshing center of summer. He is preeminent in all things (**Colossians 1:18**), including vacations and picnics and softball and long walks and cookouts. He invites us this summer: "Come to Me, all who are weary and heavy-laden, and I will give you rest." (**Matthew 11:28**). This is serious summer refreshment.

Do we want it? That is the question. Christ gives himself to us in proportion to how much we want his refreshment. "You will seek me and find me, when you seek me with all your heart" (**Jeremiah 29:13**). Encountering God's presence is a transformative experience that rejuvenates and refreshes us. This encounter can happen in several ways, each as unique as the individual seeking it. Prayer is our direct line to God, a conversation where we can pour out our hearts and receive His "Living Waters" in return.

The summer season shows the glory of God: the new angle of the rising sun; the new night-time order of summer constellations; the creation of leaves out of hard brown limbs; the pushing up of tulips; the snow-buried grass turning into soft carpets; the return of robins and the northbound honking geese; gardening and planting; even, I dare say, the survival of mosquitoes through seven months of cold weather and long lazy days outside. (continued) All these things and a thousand more, if we have eyes to see, declare the glory of God, and the work of his hands.

God is merciful to this fallen world—day by day and in all circumstances. He restrains his wrath against sin during this period of grace (**Romans 2:4**). But this world is passing! Therefore, we should be eager to share the good news about Christ to a sinful world this summer and beyond.

The earth is most beautiful at this time as the Creator made it! But it only preludes the splendor of our heavenly home. It is a foretaste of the real banquet to come. It is a video preview to the reality of what the eternal summer will be like when "The city has no need of sun or moon to shine upon it, for the glory of God is its light, and its lamp is the Lamb" (Revelation 21:23). So, you see, the summer sun is a mere pointer to the sun that will be -- The glory of God! Amen.

AARC Grant
